

INSTRUCTIONS FOR RIGHT OF WAY RECORDS FORM

This form is used primarily by County Weed Boards, Township Boards, Public Operators, and others that spray roads and other Right of Way areas. It is designed to comply with the North Dakota pesticide laws and will show all the required information if properly completed.

The top block of information is self-explanatory. Under the equipment heading, use a spray unit number or designate "hand held" or "hand wand" if applicable.

The second block contains specific site information, time and environmental information and total gallons used. Please note that there are nine (9) blocks available to the right of each entry category. This will aid in putting in each two hour time entry and two hour temperature entry as required by the law. This form is designed to be used for a full work day if the spraying is conducted in the same township.

The lower left block contains the chemical data required for all applications. There is a provision made for the mixing of two chemicals per load and the data for four (4) separate loads can be entered.

The lower right block indicates a township with section numbers that allows the applicator to be specific about the site(s) sprayed. The township and range numbers must be entered beside the respective designations on each page. A new page must be used for each township. This will ensure complete and accurate records.

The applicator must sign each page.
