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INSTRUCTIONS for weed board use in filing of forms

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Eligible weed boards are required to have levied a minimum of 3 mills taxation for noxious weed control or eradication or an amount equal to the revenue that could be raised by a levy of at least three mills.
- Reimbursement is at a 100% compensation rate for actual weed board expenditures to the limit of the program allocation. Landowner contributions are not eligible for compensation.
- Landowners are required to contribute a minimum of 20% of the cost of control and can be in the form of cash or in-kind contributions.
- The program is a landowner cost-share program.
- The program is intended as a cost-share program for control of state or county listed noxious weeds.
- Voucher for payment forms may be submitted by surface mail or as a Fax [(701) 328-2240]. The deadline for submitting is June 30th of each year.
